She will guide us in a lively discussion of our experiences in parish twinning and global solidarity. Kim Lamberty is Senior Program Advisor at Catholic Relief Services US Operations and founder of Just Haiti, a fair trade coffee program working with farmers in Haiti. Before joining CRS, Kim worked in mission in Colombia, Palestine, and the US-Mexico border. She holds a master's in International Affairs from Columbia University and a Doctor of Ministry degree in cross-cultural ministry from Catholic Theological Union.
