ROUTE INFORMATION

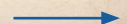
Length: 31.930 miles

Yellow route starts at St. Robert Catholic Church in Shorewood and ends at St. John XXIII (St. Peter of Alcantara) in Port Washington. Stops in between are at: Our Lady of Good Hope, Milwaukee, St. Joseph Catholic Church, Grafton, and St. John XXIII (St. Mary), Port Washington.

This route utilizes the Oak Leaf trail, the Brown Deer Trail and the Ozaukee Interurban Trail.

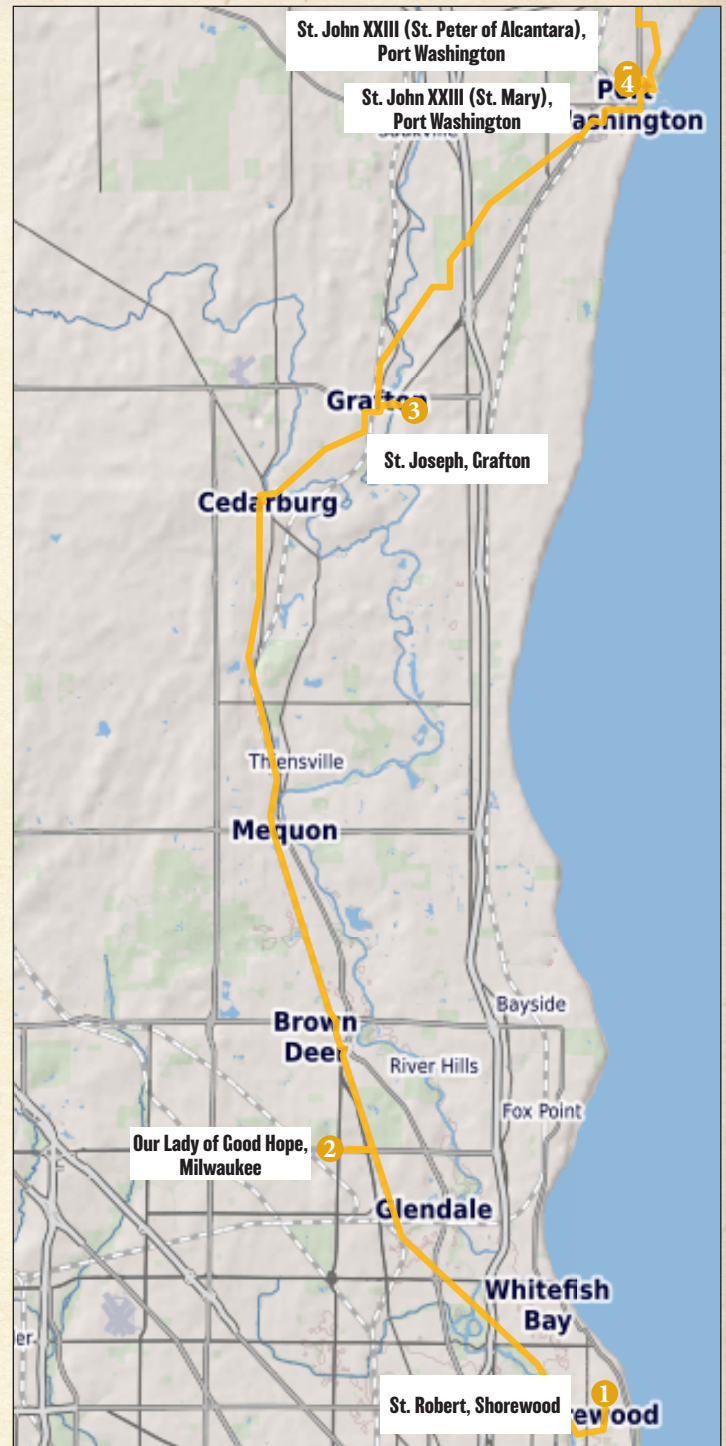

0.000		Start at Stop 1 , St. Robert Catholic Church, 4019 N. Farwell Ave, Shorewood
0.000	→	Turn right (west) onto Capitol Dr
0.024	←	Turn left onto N Maryland Ave
0.403	→	Turn right onto E Menlo Blvd
0.788	←	Turn left on North Morris Blvd (by Shorewood River Club)
0.834	→	Turn right into parking lot Go through tunnel and continue on trail around Bier Garden
1.002	←	Turn left onto Oak Leaf Trail
5.151	↗	Head right (north) on the Oak Leaf Trail
6.590	←	Turn left onto Good Hope Rd
7.037	←	Turn left onto N 41st St to arrive at Stop 2 , Our Lady of Good Hope Catholic Church, 7152 N 41st St, Milwaukee
7.105	→	Turn right onto Good Hope Rd
7.551	←	Turn left onto Oak Leaf Trail
9.306	↗	Note: Oak Leaf Trail turns into Brown Deer Trail which turns into Ozaukee Interurban Trail
15.543	↖	Slight left to stay on Ozaukee Interurban Trail
18.290	←	Turn left onto Hanover Ave
18.290	→	Turn right onto Ozaukee Interurban Trail
20.354	←	Turn left onto 7th Ave
20.686	→	Turn right onto Beech St
21.020	↗	Turn left onto Wisconsin Ave
21.280	→	Turn right onto Bridge St
	→	Turn right onto 16th Ave
	←	Turn left back onto Bridge St until you come to Stop 3 , St. Joseph Catholic Church, 1619 Washington Ave, Grafton
21.408	→	Take Bridge St to 16th Ave Turn right onto 16th Ave
21.444	←	Turn left onto Bridge St
21.740	→	Turn right onto 11th Ave. 11th Ave will connect with the Ozaukee Interurban Trail. Continue straight onto the Ozaukee Interurban Trail

29.988	←	Turn left onto N Wisconsin St Stay straight on N Franklin St

30.329	←	Turn left onto Ozaukee Interurban Trail
30.985	←	Turn left onto E Norport Dr
31.655	→	Turn right onto N Wisconsin St
