## **Reflection Questions for Parish Staffs and Pastoral Councils**

In Archbishop Listecki's column, "Help Wanted: Missionaries for a Church on the move," he expresses appreciation and need for our ordained and lay ministers in adapting to the changing needs of leadership in today's Church.

- How are the changing needs of leadership evolving in your parish?
- Are there specific and new ways in which you or your parish are able to intentionally invite people to grow in their faith and become leaders?

"A Welcome Straight from the Heart" highlights the success of St. Alphonsus' "Bring a Friend to Mass" campaign – an effective formula for any parish.

- Could you see this campaign formula being adapted for your parish?
- What time of year would be the best opportunity for such a campaign?
- How in the past have you individually invited a friend to Mass or could in the future?

Susan McNeil, director of the Nazareth Project for Marriage and Family Formation, shares her own personal transformation in "From Maintenance to Mission."

- In what ways does her experience resonate with you and your parish?
- How are opportunities for people to encounter Jesus and enter more deeply into a relationship with God being offered?
