Day 1 Monday, September 26: Depart USA

Transfer by private coach from the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center in Milwaukee to Chicago O'Hare International Airport for our transatlantic flight via Lufthansa Airlines to Prague, Czech Republic.

Dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served on board.

Day 2 <u>Tuesday, September 27: Arrive in Prague</u>

Arrive at Prague International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager upon our exit from Customs. Claim our luggage and we will be on our way to Prague, the "City of 100 Spires." Before we check in at our hotel, we'll stop to visit Loreta, a large pilgrimage destination in the Czech Republic. It consists of a cloister, the church of the Lord's Birth, a Holy Hut, and the clock tower with its famous chime. The chapel is most known for its peal, heard since August 15, 1695. Celebrate Mass at the shrine. Visit the Treasury Musem. Continue to our hotel for check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Prague. (B,D)

Day 3 <u>Wednesday</u>, September 28: Highlight Tour of Prague

Breakfast at our hotel. Today will be spent getting acquainted with the magnificent city of Prague, which is undoubtedly one of the most picturesque cities in the world. The "City of 100 Spires" was spared from destruction during World War II and still contains beautiful examples of architecture in a number of different styles, including Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque. Our guided tour of Prague includes the Castle District (Hradčany) and St. Vitus' Cathedral, used for the inauguration of presidents. Here, we can find the tomb of St. Wenceslas and former rulers of the Czech Kingdom. This beautifully decorated chapel is dedicated to the patron of Czech lands, St. Wenceslas, a Bohemian Prince from the Premyslid dynasty who was assassinated by his own brother. St. Wenceslas Chapel still keeps the holy relics of the saint. Continue on to the Basilica of St. George and Prague Castle. We will also see the Golden Lane, a row of tiny artisans' shops built outside the castle walls in medieval times. Stroll through Malá Strana with its beautiful architectural buildings. Independent lunch.

Visit the Church of Our Lady of Victory, known for the Shrine of the Infant Jesus of Prague. Celebrate Mass at the shrine. After Mass, visit the beautiful, statue-lined Charles Bridge. Continue to the Old Town Square, which is lined with historic buildings and churches. See Ŏld Town Hall and its beautiful Gothic tower with a bay chapel and unique astronomical clock. Every hour between 9 a.m. and 11 p.m., the twelve apostles appear. Continue to visit the Jewish Ouarter, known as Josefov, located between the Old Town Square and the Vltava River. Its torrid history dates back to the 13th century, when the Jewish community in Prague was ordered to vacate their disparate homes and settle in one area. These buildings form the bestpreserved complex of Jewish historical monuments in the whole of Europe. Six synagogues remain, including the Old-New Synagogue and the Spanish Synagogue, plus the Jewish Town Hall and the Old Jewish Cemetery, which is the most remarkable of its kind in Europe.

This evening, we will be transferred to a popular Czech restaurant for a special dinner. While dining and tasting the traditional specialties of Czech cuisine, enjoy a program featuring folk music, songs, and dances.

Overnight at our hotel in Prague.

Day 4 Thursday, September 29: Melk Abbey | Vienna

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, continue to the Church of St. Havel, where St. John Nepomuk served as pastor from 1380 to 1390. Havel (Gall) Quarter was an important part of Prague's Old Town. The Parish Church of St. Gall, founded by King Wenceslaus I of Bohemia in 1232, was one of Prague's four main churches. Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Havel. After Mass, we'll leave Prague and drive across the Danube Valley to Melk. Independent lunch upon arrival in Melk.

We'll visit the Benedictine Abbey of Melk, crowning the rocky hill overlooking the Danube. Founded in 1702, it is the best sample of Baroque architecture in Austria. Its library contains over 80,000 books and 2,000 manuscripts, all on religious subjects. After our visit, we'll continue to Vienna, the Music Capital of the World! Vienna is the city of Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Strauss. Check-in at our hotel. (B.D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

Day 5 Friday, September 30: Imperial Vienna | Schönbrunn Palace

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with morning Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral, Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice. After Mass, we will have a tour of the cathedral, which houses a wealth of art treasures. After our visit we'll pass by the Plague Column, or Trinity Column, erected after the great plague in 1679. Continue on to visit the Capuchin Church, which contains the imperial vaults. By coach, we'll pass the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing the Vienna State Opera, museums, the House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. After our morning tour we'll be dropped off by the Kärntner Strasse, Vienna's famous pedestrian zone. Enjoy the diversified mix of historical buildings, traditional shops, and stylish international stores. Be sure to try Viennese specialties, like a Wiener Melange with Apfelstrudel or a Linzer Torte in one of the many traditional cafés!

This afternoon we will tour Schönbrunn Palace, the former summer residence of the imperial family. Ever since it was completed in 1780 during the reign of Maria-Theresia, the palace was the favorite residence of the Habsburg monarchs.

This evening enjoy a typical Heuriger dinner with wine and music in Grinzing. Overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

Day 6 Saturday, October 1: Heilingenkreuz Abbey Mariazell Shrine

Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we'll leave Vienna to visit Heiligenkreuz Abbey. **Celebrate** Mass upon arrival. After Mass, we will have a tour of the Cistercian monastery, founded by St. Leopold in 1133 at the request of his son Otto, soon to be abbot of the Cistercian monastery of Morimond in Burgundy and afterwards Bishop of Freising. Its first twelve monks together with their abbot, Gottschalk, came from Morimond at the request of Leopold III. They called their abbey Heiligenkreuz (Holy Cross) as a sign of their devotion to redemption by the cross. Independent lunch at the abbey.

After lunch we'll drive along one of the most beautiful roads with spectacular views of the Alps, rushing streams, and small market towns. Our destination is the Shrine of Our Lady of Mariazell, nestled in the Alpine mountains of Austria. The Baroque basilica dedicated to Our Lady stands at the center of Mariazell. See the miraculous statue in the Chapel of Miracles, which stands directly over the place where the Benedictine monk, Magnus, established his monastic cell in 1157, marking the ground where the first miracle of Mariazell took place. Prayer and reflection at the shrine. Check-in at our hotel in Mariazell. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mariazell. (B,D)

Day 7 Sunday, October 2: Mariazell | Florian Abbey | Salzburg

Celebrate early morning Mass at the Shrine of Mariazell. After Mass, return to our hotel for breakfast. Then we'll leave Mariazell for upper Austria to visit Linz and Florian Abbey. Independent lunch in Linz.

Tour the Abbey of St. Florian. The largest abbey in upper Austria, it is a renowned cultural center and has been occupied since the eleventh century by Canons of St. Augustine. The present buildings are in the purest Baroque style. The monastery was entirely rebuilt from 1686 to 1751—first under the initial direction of Carlo Antonio Carlone, then finished by Jakob Prandtauer. We will have the opportunity to view the famous Bruckner Organ and visit Bruckner's Grave in the abbey crypt. Afterward, we'll continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River. Check-in at our hotel. (B.D)Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

Day 8 Monday, October 3: Salzburg

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will visit the Shrine of Maria Plain in Salzburg to celebrate Mass. In 1633, an undamaged painting of the Blessed Mother was found in the ruins of a wooden house destroyed by fire. In 1656, a small wooden chapel was built at this location and in 1710, the chapel was rebuilt to house the first copy of the miraculous image. In 1951, Pope Pius XII conferred the title of this Shrine to "Basilica Minor." After Mass, we'll have a guided walking tour in Salzburg beginning with the Getreidegasse, a pedestrian street lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings and the house where Mozart was born. The dominant feature of Salzburg's skyline is the Hohensalzburg fortress on Mönchsberg Mountain. Built into the side of Mönchsberg is the Festspiedlhaus, a large festival hall and home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See the Residenzbrunnen Fountain next to the Salzburger Dom Cathedral. Visit the Benedictine St. Peter's Abbey with its striking Christian architecture. The cemetery and catacombs are a must-see for fans of The Sound of Music. Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to explore Salzburg on your own. Perhaps you will stop in at one of Salzburg's many cafes for ice coffee or hot chocolate and cake, a tradition that most Austrians enjoy. You might like to take the cogwheel train up to the mighty Hohensalzburg Fortress, the former residence of the powerful Archbishops of Salzburg. From the terrace high above the city you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the old town with its never ending charm. Or visit the world-famous Mirabell Gardens, built along a north-south azis and oriented towards the Hohensalzburg Fortress and the Salzburg Dom Cathedral. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B)

Day 9 <u>Tuesday, October 4: Bavaria in the Footsteps of Pope</u> **Benedict XVI**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll depart on our excursion to Bavaria to visit the little town of Marktl am Inn. Pope Benedict XVI was born here on April 16th, 1927 and baptized the same day. The baptismal font is located in the town's small museum. Continue to the nearby town of Altötting, home to one of Germany's most celebrated shrines, the Chapel of Mercy, and the 750-year-old Black Madonna. Altötting is known as the Lourdes of Germany, as the chapel's 13th century statue of the Blessed Virgin is credited with numerous miracles. Altötting has been a place of pilgrimage in Germany for over 500 years. Celebrate Mass at the shrine. Independent lunch.

Continue to visit Freising, where Pope Benedict studied at the University of Theology. He later became became Archbishop of Munich and Freising. Visit the outstanding St. Mary's Cathedral (Mariendom), consecrated in 1250. After our visit we'll continue to Garmisch-Partenkirchen in south Bavaria for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Garmisch-Partenkirchen. (B,D)

Day 10 Wednesday, October 5: Wieskirche Neuschwanstein Castle | Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll visit the Wieskirche, the impressive Rococo-era Pilgrimage Church of Wies designed in the 1740s. Celebrate Mass at the Wieskirche. After Mass, we'll explore King Ludwig's majestic castle, the Cinderella-style fortress Neuschwanstein. This dream-like castle was built in 1869 according to sketches of a theatrical decorator, explaining the whimsical atmosphere. Go back in time as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas, the throne rooms and music halls, King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings, and an artificial Grotto that recalls opera themes of his friend, composer Richard Wagner. Independent lunch. Free afternoon to enjoy the town of Garmisch-Partenkirchen. Farewell Bavarian dinner at an iconic regional restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Garmisch-Partenkirchen. (B,D)

Day 11 <u>Thursday, October 6: Return to the USA</u>

Early box breakfast and transfer to Munich Airport for our return flight to Chicago. Private coach transfer will be provided from O'Hare Airport to the Archdiocean Pastoral Center in Milwaukee. (B)

However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure (additional fees will apply). An increase in airfare may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage, per person, is included at most hotels.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds and private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed; however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. **Single rooms are limited and may be requested at time of booking.
