ACTION STEPS:

- 1. Make sure all materials listed above are enclosed.
- 2. Promotional weekend for the Combined Collections: Catholic Ministries in The United States is June 3-4, 2023. Please...
 - Use bulletin insert and announcement
 - Include the bulletin inserts in bulletins during the weeks preceding the collection
 - Read the letter from Archbishop Listecki
 - Read pulpit announcement; use background information and sample intercessions

- Remind parishioners about the **Combined Collections: Church in the United States** mailing they will receive at home. The mail date will be **May 29, 2023**. Encourage them to use the pledge card and envelope they receive to make their gift.

Announce that the collection will be taken June 10-11, 2023 for the Combined Collections: Catholic Ministries in the United States. They may bring their envelope to church.

3. Even though most will mail their donations directly, please take a collection for the **Combined Collections: Catholic Ministries in the United States** at all Masses in June. This is an important invitation for non-registered members to support these valuable causes.

4. Any returns to parishes should be sent to the bank lockbox (in the self-addressed envelopes provided) by July 14. Parishes will receive Combined Collections reports from the Development Office along with their September Catholic Stewardship Appeal reports. The report shows the amount contributed and total of parishioners from your parish.

Parishioner response will parallel your level of encouragement.

Dear Pastor/Administrator/Parish Director,

This year's annual Combined Collections: Church in the United States appeal will take place next month, and I wanted to take this opportunity to share details about the collection with you.

This year's collection will be held June 10-11, 2023 and will focus on five ministries that have a meaningful impact on our local and national communities. These ministries include:

- Black and Indian Missions
- Catholic Campaign for Human Development
- Catholic Communication Campaign
- Catholic University of America
- Fund for Religious Retirement

Five bulletin inserts (available in English and Spanish) have been created for use within your parish community, and are excellent educational tools. The ideal timing for use of these inserts would be in the weeks leading up to the collection weekend. Of course, you are free to use these inserts at any time during the year to share information about these important ministries.

Your enthusiastic support of the appeal is an important factor in good participation in the collection. We realize that it may be difficult to preach on five causes, as there are many other demands. However, your endorsement of the appeal would be most helpful and very much appreciated.

The mailing your parishioners receive will include return envelopes addressed to our bank lockbox for deposit and recording. *If parishioners return these envelopes in your collection basket, please send the unopened envelopes to the bank in the specially addressed envelopes we have provided you.* It is critical that we receive the return envelopes this way in order to give proper credit to each parishioner's record. This is especially important for tax purposes. We have also enclosed extra envelopes for visitors or for new parishioners who may not be a part of our database. If there are parish staff members or volunteers who assist with the **Combined Collections: Church in the United States** appeal, please share this information with them or provide them with my contact information so I can answer any questions.
