Best Practices Shared by Parishes

- Invite parishioners to donate their clipped coupons: coffee, food, diapers, children's vitamins, shampoo/soap, dish/laundry detergent, and household cleaning products.
- ◆ Host a themed collection, e.g., Super Bowl (canned soups), Baby Shower (infant formula, baby food, diapers)
- Conduct a "reverse" collection during the 5th Sunday (small slips of paper indicating a preferred item to bring to Mass for the food pantry next weekend)
- \$5 or \$10 gift cards from local grocery or pharmacy to purchase fresh produce or medication
- ◆ Host a local fire department spokesperson to connect with residential home owners that are eligible for free smoke detectors. Or host an employment agency to help find employment
