SWIFT/BIC: A code affiliated with the Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunications (SWIFT) identifying international financial institutions. Usually consisting of 8 or 11 alphanumeric characters with the 5th and 6th characters identifying the country. The BIC is an 8 or 11-character code also known as the SWIFT address. The BIC could be entered as: BARCGB22 or DEUTDE3B400.

IBAN: International Bank Account Number (IBAN) identifies the routing instructions for the receiving country. Consists of up to 30 alpha-numeric characters, which typically designate the bank and customer account numbers. Do not include dashes or spaces.
