## School Sisters of Notre Dame - Africa

There are 89 School Sisters of Notre Dame serving in the Province of Africa. They minister in the countries of Kenya, Nigeria, Ghana, Sierra Leone and The Gambia.

SSND first went to West Africa in 1970 and have had a continuing presence since then with 77 African professed Sisters, 7 novices and 12 postulants. The Sisters are principals, teachers, and administrators in school settings. A small number of Sisters are in health ministries and a number serve in pastoral and social ministries.

SSND chooses to work with the poor, women and youth. They emphasize early education to give children a good foundation for learning. They are currently building two schools in Nigeria and Kenya. The school in Kenya is in the Diocese of Homa Bay where the Sisters run the Notre Dame. Children's Outreach which serves poor children and those orphaned by HIV/AIDS.
