Currently there about 850 members serving in Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania and a few sisters in USA-Mission. The ministries of the LSOSF include care for the homeless street children, the orphans, children with diverse disabilities, single mothers, the elderly, people living with HIV/Aids and feeding programs for children from poor families.

The LSOSF are also involved in education, health care and pastoral and diverse social service in the missions.
