Daughters of Divine Love

The Daughters of Divine Love was established on July 16, 1969 by Bishop Godfrey Mary Paul Okoye, cssp. The congregation was founded during the Nigerla/Biafra war and after Vatican Council II. Initially, it started with young girls who helped to share food, clothing, water, accommodations, and medication to the refugees who were homeless.

Today the congregation has more than one thousand nuns working in eighteen countries around the world. They work with the very poor in society: the rejected, homeless, challenged children and adults in homes and streets, home-battered women and children, and babies affected by drugs.

They also work in schools of every level and hospitals, as parish assistants, chaplains, caring services, directors of religious education, eucharist ministers, CCD and RCIA teachers, and youth ministers in the schools and parishes.

The mission and vision of the Daughters of Divine Love is a call to participate in the saving mission of Jesus Christ.
