| Wearing of Face Coverings | No face coverings required, with charity toward parishioners who prefer to wear a face covering. |
| Reception of Communion | After consultation with the District Deans, maintain reception of Communion under one species. |
| Anointing of Covid patients | Contact Vicar for Clergy for instructions. |
| Visiting/Taking Communion to Parishioners who are Homebound | Yes. |
| Visiting Parishioners/Taking Communion into Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Assisted Living or Rehab Facilities and Senior Living Complexes | Yes, following facility guidelines. |
| Children's Liturgy of the Word | Yes. |
| Distribution of Holy Water | Yes. |
