The Newsletters include practical information of interest to pastors, e.g., information regarding priests' pension plan, confirmation, Lent, funeral and burial instructions, Mass intentions, health insurance, etc. The collection also includes issues 12-14 of the "Chancery Bulletin" (1934); see Box 1, Folder 1.
