The Department for Education participated in the evangelizing mission of the Church by providing service, support, and professional resources to the Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee to ensure their long-term viability and excellence in faith development, academics, and formation of the whole student.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The Department for Education Bulletin was a monthly publication that included pertinent information for teachers and school administrators of Catholic schools within the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Topics include the teaching of religion in the classroom, educational policy (particularly policy in Milwaukee County), teaching objectives, and monthly messages from the superintendent. Also included are calendars with events for principals and teachers.
