Biographical Note

Francis Xavier Schneider was born June 6, 1869 at Muscoda, Wisconsin. His parents were Valentin and Josephine Schneider from Waldmaessingen, Wuerttemberg, Germany. In September 1884, Francis entered the St. Francis Seminary, where, after completing his studies, he was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Otto Zardetti on June 24, 1893. His first appointment was as an assistant at Holy Trinity Parish in Milwaukee; he assumed his duties on July 29, 1893. One year later to the day he received his appointment as pastor of St. Joseph's Parish in Fort Atkinson, with the mission parish of Immaculate Conception at Milton Junction. Thereafter he served successively at Sacred Heart Sanitarium, Milwaukee, June 16, 1903; as chaplain for the Dominican Sisters Institute at Corliss, Sturtevant, October 1906; and in pastoral appointments at St. Mary's Sheboygan Falls, 1912; St. John's, Montello, 1914; St. John's, Clyman, 1916; St. Joseph's, East Bristol, 1917; Immaculate Conception, Saukville, October 2, 1922; and Immaculate Conception, Milton Junction, June 23, 1933. All of these assignments were within the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Father Schneider resigned his pastorate at Milton Junction on November 21, 1944. He lived in retirement at Fort Atkinson until his death on October 1, 1965.
