The leadership of Frederick Xavier Katzer, the third archbishop of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, is documented by biographical information and correspondence mainly from 1890-1903. Correspondence from Cardinal James Gibbons, Archbishop Francis Satolli, and Bishop Sebastian Messmer; a scrapbook concerning conferring of the Pallium in 1891; the first pastoral letter; and material regarding the Bennett Law are included.
