

The following is the finding aid for the Ludwigs-Missionverein Correspondence collection located at the Archdiocese of Milwaukee Archives. A finding aid is a catalog tool used in archives that briefly describes the material found in a collection. These records are not available digitally unless otherwise noted. Researchers must make an appointment with an archivist to view the material.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

Collection consists of correspondence from Wisconsin priests and missionaries to the Munich, Germany based missionary society, whose purpose was to allow the German (Bavarian) laity to support missionary activity in the United States. The Society was founded in 1838. The letters provide insight into the growth and development of the early church in Wisconsin.

Virtually the entire collection is in German, though series 1 and 2 have been transcribed. The collection contains no original documents, only copies. Most of the collection deals with eastern and southeastern Wisconsin, though series 3 consists entirely of correspondence from the newly formed Diocese of LaCrosse (1868) to Munich (1868-1913).

Correspondents include: John M. Henni, Michael Heiss, Joseph Salzmann, James Schwebach, Francis X. Paulhuber, Anthonly Muehlenkamp, William Daniels, and Joseph F. Mueller.

General note

All of series 1 has been previously published, in translation, in "The Salesianum" from January 1942 (vol. 37) through October 1947 (vol. 42). For further information see also various volumes of the "Annalen Der Glaubensverbreitung" of Munich 1859-73 for other published letters/reports from Wisconsin.

Box and Folder List *This is a list of folders names within the collection. The collection is arranged into three series of correspondence. Series 1 and 3 are arranged chronologically; series 2 contains an index to four volumes of letters, transcriptions of original letters and copies of original letters in random order.* "B" is an abbreviation for box and "F" is an abbreviation for folder.
