This collection of a native Milwaukee priest and former professor at St. Francis Seminary contains: biographical information and newspaper clippings (1962); consecration materials (1942); correspondence (1943-1955), the majority of it with Archbishop Moses E. Kiley; death information (1973); and programs from his installation as bishop of Madison (1946).
