

The following is the finding aid for the Brother Anthony Seeman Financial Records collection located at the Archdiocese of Milwaukee Archives. Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection*. This collection contains two financial ledgers (1854-1874) and a folder of miscellaneous items that belonged to Anthony Seemann, who was one of the Brother's helping at St. Francis Seminary and apparently was a cobbler. The ledgers include St. Francis Seminary financial information (1868-1974). They are largely in German.

Box and Folder List *This is a list of folders names within the collection. The folders have been arranged chronologically. "B" is an abbreviation for box and "F" is an abbreviation for folder. This list will help the researcher narrow down exactly what folder they want to look at.*
