Biographical Note

Rev. Maximilian Gaertner, O.Praem. was an Austrian Norbertine missionary priest ministered in Wisconsin from 1846 to 1858. His focus was on ministering to the German immigrants of southern and southwestern Wisconsin.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains several original letters written by Maximillian Gaertner. The collection also includes a folder of biographical information, several photostats of diary sketches, and a folder of miscellaneous items. Also included are typescripts of his diary. However, the original 10 diaries are located at the St. Norbert Abbey in Green Bay and have been fully digitized. The diaries record his work and travels from 1846 until he returned to Wilten Abbey in Austria in 1858. Materials in the collection are in German.
