Historical Note

The Polish Church War refers to the conflict between the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee (Wisconsin) and Polish Catholic principally in the early 20th century. Two rival newspapers debated Polish issues, particularly appointment of a Polish bishop. The Nowiny Polski (Polish News) was established by Archbishop Sebastian G. Messmer. The Kuryer Polski (Polish Courier) was owned by Michael Kruszka, a Polish nationalist, and was condemned as forbidden reading for Polish Catholics on February 1, 1912. Rev. Wenceslaus Kruszka, a step-brother of Michael Kruszka, corresponded extensively on issues with Messmer.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The strife between the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee (Wisconsin) and Polish Catholic principally in the early 20th Century is documented by correspondence from 1893-1949, biographical documents of Rev. Wenceslaus Kruszka, and other publications and legal documents. Included are a large amount of correspondence between Archbishop Sebastian G. Messmer and Rev. Wenceslaus Kruszka (1901-1926) and personal notes of Messmer.
