**Biographical Note**

This collection reflects the life and career of Eugene F. Bleidorn, ordained a Roman Catholic priest in 1942, he left the ordained ministry in 1970 and successfully pursued a second career as a health services administrator. The collection consists primarily of material related to Bleidorn's career as a priest. He was active as a teacher at St. Francis de Sales Seminary and a leader of lay Catholic groups including Young Christian Workers, Young Christian Students, and Christian Family Movement. Later, as pastor of St. Boniface Parish, Milwaukee, Bleidorn was a well-known participant in local civil rights issues.

**Scope/Content Note** *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection contains records of various aspects of Eugene F. Bleidorn's life. The collection covers a variety of topics and includes many personal writings, notes, and speeches, so the collection is divided into 18 different series: Pre-ordination; Ordination; St. Francis Seminary; Cardijn Center; St. Scholastica, Bristol; St. Boniface, Milwaukee; St. Mary, Racine; Transition; Post-priesthood/State of Wisconsin; Tudor Oaks Retirement Home; Steven Bryant Nursing Home; St. Camillus Institute; Retirement; Articles and speeches; Publications; Oversize materials; Audio tapes and miscellaneous items; Photographs/autobiography; record albums; and Cardijn Center binders. It also includes administrative records of the parishes, organizations, and institutions Bleidorn served.
