Access

Open/unrestricted except for financial records, census records, student transcripts, and marriage case files.

Historical Note

Holy Trinity Church in Racine was organized by Slovak Catholics on May 24, 1914, under the direction of Rev. Victor Blahunka, pastor of St. Anthony Parish in Kenosha. In May of 1916, lots were purchased on Franklin and 20th Streets for a new church building. The cornerstone was laid in 1919 and the church was dedicated in September of 1920. The school opened in September 1949 and was staffed by Dominican sisters. An addition to the school was dedicated in November 1955. Groundbreaking for the new church was in October 1956, with the blessing of the new church in January 1958. The school closed in May of 1987. Holy Trinity Church merged with the other Racine parishes of St. Rose of Lima, St. Casimir, Holy Name, and St. Stanislaus to form St. Richard Congregation on July 1, 1998.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection includes parish and school administrative records and correspondence, committee and society meeting minutes, building construction records, and marriage records. The Catholic Slovak Social Club's meeting minutes and the Junior Holy Name Society's meeting minutes are both contained within the same volume.
