Biographical Note

Msgr William Schuit was born March 5, 1921 in Racine, Wisconsin. He entered St. Francis Seminary in Spetember, 1934 and was ordained a priest on September 29, 1945. He was first assigned to St. Monica Parish in Whitefish Bay for one year, and was then sent to school in Rome for four years. He was then assigned to St. Gall parish in Milwaukee for one year. He was then assigned as a professor at St. Francis Seminary in November of 1951 and taught Biblical Studies, Hebrew and Archeology. From June 1965 through fall of 1976 Msgr Schuit was appointed Rector of St. Francis Seminary. In 1976-1980 he was the Director of Development for the Seminary. In October of 1980 he was appointed pastor of St. Eugene Parish in Fox Point until his death on October 18, 1984.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection mainly reflects the work of Msgr. Schuit as a Professor of Biblical Studies and Hebrew at St. Francis Seminary. Folder 1 contains a limited amount of correspondence, folders 2-16 contain syllabi and notes from his lectures at the Seminary. Folder 17 contains course notes, possibly from his own seminary studies. Folders 19-23 contain notes and outlines from his various talks, sermons and speeches.
