Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

This collection consists of a number of resource types including: books, documents, objects, photographs, videos, audio cassettes and slides.

The Administrative series includes most bulletins published between 1957 and 2007. The series contains official documents which include the articles of incorporation, the decree for the erection of Schoenstatt shrine and the decree to erect the stations of the cross, issued in 1988 by Archbishop Rembert Weakland. Parish council meeting minutes and parishioner lists comprise a sizable portion of this series.

Documentation about repairs and remodeling as well as church specifications are included in the Building series. Records regarding ADA compliance, asbestos, electricity, HVAC, roof and fire safety are located in this series. Documentation on the parish property and school construction may also be found in this series.

The Finance series includes Archdiocesan Assessments as well as balance sheets, budgets, financial statements, and general ledgers. Additionally, this series includes insurance information, proxies and waivers and school choice audit reports.

Information about the parish's founding members is included in the History series along with newspaper articles and parish history documentation.

Photographs & Audio/Visual is the largest series in the collection. It is comprised of audio cassettes, videos, slides, and photographs. Photographs comprise the bulk of this series. These include photographs of parish committees and organizations as well as scouts and sports teams. Photographs of the building include interior and exterior photographs as well as the construction of the playground. Parish priest photographs have been identified and collocated into individual folders. A wealth of photographs of student activities, including Catholic Schools Week, Christmas plays and eighth grade trips to Washington, D.C. dating from the 1970s to the 2000s are in this series. Formal class photos from 1978 to 2000 are also included.

The VHS videos are broken down into 4 subject categories: Christmas Plays and Programs, First Holy Communion, Miscellaneous and School. Additionally, there are three camcorder videos from November 6-7, 2003, which record an Honors Dinner and trip to the Milwaukee Art Museum. The three audio cassettes are published recordings of “St. Philip Neri Folk Choir Sings Christmas 1993.”

Historical Note

St. Philip Neri Parish was located at 5566 N. 68th Street in Milwaukee, WI. The original parish boundaries were Villard Avenue on the south from 76th Street to Florist Avenue; the railroad tracks on the north from 84th Street to 55th Street; and 55th Street south from the railroad tracks to Silver Spring Drive, along Silver Spring Drive to 64th Street south to Villard Avenue.

The church cornerstone was laid in 1957. Rev. Aloysius Ahler, pastor (1957-1978) presided at the cornerstone laying. Mass was held in the basement until the upper portion of the building was completed. Many parishioners helped to build the church, rectory, and school. By 1958 the parish had a membership of 1200 families. St. Philip Neri School was completed in 1961. In 1984 there was a large remodeling which included a new altar area, stained glass windows and carpeting. At this time artist Judy Bartolomew created the hand-carved statue of St. Philip Neri. The sculpture even featured the brooms that the saint allegedly used to tease unexpected listeners into appreciating the goodness of God.

In 1958 the Schoenstatt Sisters of Mary began their ministry. The Schoenstatt Shrine, built in 1961, is visual evidence of the impact of this order. This shrine is one of at least 80 similar shrines located around the world. The first sisters came from Germany in 1949. The sisters who would serve at St. Philip Neri parish came from a house of the Schoenstatt Sisters of Mary in Madison and were the first Americans to join the Schoenstatt community. The order ran the school and religious education programs. Miss Zinda, principal of the school from the 1970s through the 1990s, was part of the Schoenstatt Sisters of Mary. When working publicly and professionally Miss Zinda and her fellow sisters wore lay clothes and used their family names. Miss Zinda is featured prominently in the Photographs & Audio/Visual series.

During the parish’s 50-year history several priests served the congregation. Rev. Aloysius Ahler served from 1957 to 1978. Rev. Nicholas Goebel served as pastor from 1978 to 1982. Rev. Thomas Venne took over the pastorship in 1982 and would serve until 1990. Rev. David Lictner would serve as pastor until 1992. Rev. John Yockey became pastor in 1992 and served until 1997. During this period, the parish celebrated its 40th anniversary and the school celebrated its 35th anniversary. The late 1990s saw a series of administrators serving the parish including: Rev. John Brophy (1997-1998), Rev. Michael Strachota (1999) and Rev. Melvin Breit (1999 – 2003). Rev. Dennis Witz would serve as pastor until the congregation merger in 2007. In 2007, St. Philip Neri merged with Corpus Christi, Our Lady of Sorrows, and Mary Queen of Martyrs to form Blessed Savior Parish.
