

Girl Scout Leadership Award



The Archdiocese of Milwaukee Catholic Committee on Girl Scouts has created a Catholic Youth Leadership Award to support current members of Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) who are Catholic, have shown leadership and plan to attend Catholic Teen events in the current school year.

It is not a "need-based" scholarship but an award to help with expenses at leadership events such as NCYC or a teen mission trip. Applications must be received at least two months in advance of the event to be considered.

Girl Scouts who will use their talents to impact their communities and the world, who have shown dedication, character, promise, determination and a desire to apply those qualities to their daily life should apply.

Eligibility:

- Be a current member of GSUSA at Cadette, Senior or Ambassador level.
- Be an attending, active member of her local parish in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.
- Write a brief summary of how Girl Scouts has impacted her personal development, leadership, and faith journey that would be shared via the Catholic Committee on Girl Scouts e-newsletter.
- *Optional:* If attending NCYC, attend session(s) that are suggested for Girl Scout members.

All applications will be considered. Cash awards will vary between \$50 and \$100. You can email your application to jacgozzy1@gmail.com or mail to:
