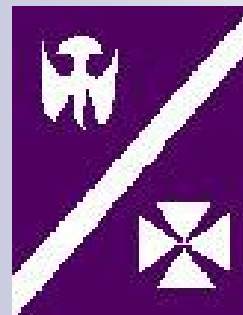

## FORMATION WORKSHOP OFFERINGS FOR DEACONS' WIVES

The new model of formation encourages the participation and inclusion of the aspirants, candidates and deacons' wives in the program. They are invited to participate and engage in the formational and social activities developed for them during the years of formation.

Participation, acceptance and support of the wife in her husband's vocation and formation to the diaconate are imperative for his continued participation in formation.
